Upon receipt of this application we will match it against available dogs to determine if we have any suitable Shelties for your household. If a Sheltie is available that meets your needs, and we feel it will be a good fit with your household, we will discuss the Sheltie with you. If you are interested in the Sheltie, we will arrange a meeting with other household members and pets. If after meeting the Sheltie you and our representative believe that the Sheltie is a good fit, you will sign an adoption contract and the Sheltie will go home with you, on a 2-week trial period. We will follow-up with you to ensure that any initial questions are answered and the adoption is going well. If everything goes well, then the adoption is considered finalized at the end of 2 weeks. Should things not go well at any time, you can return the dog to us, we will refund your adoption fees during that 2-week period only. Should you decide after the 2 weeks that you do not wish to keep the dog, adoption fees are not refunded. THE DOG MUST BE RETURNED TO **SRofSME**. Terms of Adoption

- 1. **Return:** The adopted dog may be returned to **SRofSME** within two weeks of the date of adoption for full refund if the adopter is not satisfied with any aspect of the adoption. After two weeks from the above date, no refund will be given, even if the dog is returned to **SRofSME**.
- 2. <u>Transfer of Ownership:</u> The adopted dog may not be transferred to any other person for any reason. If the undersigned is forced to relinquish custody of the dog at any time, said dog will only be relinquished back to *SRofSME*.
- 3. **Refund:** There will be no refund or reimbursement for any expenses incurred by the adopter for the adopted dog, even if it is returned to *SRofSME*.
- 4. <u>Health Program:</u> The adopted dog will be cared for humanely, including adequate food, shelter, water, and veterinary care and will be licensed in accordance with the laws in the jurisdiction in which he resides. The dog is to be exercised in a fenced yard or on a leash.
- 5. <u>Reason for Adoption:</u> The adopted dog is to be kept as a house pet; it shall not be used for medical or any other experimental purposes; it shall not be chained or tied, and it shall not be used for breeding.
- 6. Loss: If the adopted dog is lost or stolen, the adopter will notify **SRofSME** within twenty-four (24) hours.
- 7. Reservation of Rights: Sheltie Rescue of Southern Maine reserves the right to enforce this contract in order to protect the welfare of the adopted dog. It is understood that SRofSME may examine and make inquiries about said dog at any time. If the terms and conditions of the Adoption Agreement are not upheld, SRofSME reserves the right to terminate the Agreement and to reclaim the dog. And will do so under the Welfare laws of the State of Maine.
- 8. <u>Guarantees or Representations:</u> I/we understand that *SRofSME* has made "NO" guarantees, promises or representations concerning the temperament of this Sheltie or it's fitness as a pet or for any other purposes.
- 9. <u>Damages:</u> Further, I/we understand that neither *SRofSME* nor any individual member will be held responsible for any problems or injuries caused by this Sheltie.
- 10. <u>Indemnity and Release:</u> If any action or failure to act on the part of the Adopter(s) shall result in any claim, suit, loss, damage, injury, death or liability, the Adopter(s) agree to defend, indemnify and hold *SRofSME* harmless and pay all costs and expenses, including legal fees, any settlement, award or judgement with respect thereto. Adopter(s) release *SRofSME* from any and all liabilit of costs or damages caused by the dog after placement with the Adopter(s) including but not limited to damage to or destruction of property and or injury to any person.
- 11. **Return Check Charge**: There will be a \$35.00 charge on all returned checks.

Other Points to Remember

- Fees: The only fee involved is to cover our expenses. Some of these dogs require extra medical care or special rehabilitation which will entail much greater expense. We do not require, but would appreciate any extra donation to help cover these expenses. The adoption fees will be as follows.
 - 1. Up to age 2: \$450.00 2. 3 yrs. to 7 yrs.: \$300.00
 - 3. 8 yrs. and over: \$275.00
 - 4. A Senior dog to a senior human (65+) \$150.00
- Spaying/Neutering: Some Shelties relinquished to us have already been altered; however, some will be in need of the altering operation. It is a requirement that all Shelties placed for adoption by *SRofSME* are to be spayed or neutered.
- Contracts: All adopters of rescue dogs will be asked to sign an Adoption Agreement. This contract is legal and binding. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY.
- Miscellaneous: We recommend you follow a regular inoculation program established by your veterinarian to guarantee your dog stays healthy. You will receive a complete medical history on your sheltie, as best as can be determined or documented. You must also have the dog licensed in accordance with the laws where you live. Since we do not know you personally, the information for the Adoption Request Questionnaire (which is requested of anyone seeking a rescue sheltie) will help us to match up the right kind of sheltie for your family. We place our shelties only in good, loving homes, and we screen prospective adopters thoroughly.
